- Relax on the famous steps and enjoy people-watching.
-  **Piazza di Spagna, Rome**

8:30 PM – DINNER AT ARMANDO AL PANTHEON



- Classic Roman dining is known for authentic pasta dishes.

- Visit the largest church in the world and climb the dome.
-  **Piazza San Pietro, Vatican City**
-  **Advance Booking:** Free entry; Dome climb requires ticket

3:30 PM – CASTEL SANT'ANGELO



- Explore the historic fortress and enjoy riverside views.
-  **Lungotevere Castello, Rome**
-  **Advance Booking:** Recommended

5:30 PM – PIAZZA NAVONA



- Admire the fountains and vibrant street artists.
-  **Piazza Navona, Rome**

6:30 PM – THE PANTHEON



- See the world's largest unreinforced concrete dome.
-  **Piazza della Rotonda, Rome**
-  **Advance Booking:** Recommended (Especially weekends)

8:30 PM – DINNER AT TONNARELLO (TRASTEVERE)



- Famous for Cacio e Pepe in the lively Trastevere area.
-  **Via della Paglia, Rome**

Hidden Gems & Gardens

9:30 AM – BORGHESE GALLERY & GARDENS



- View masterpieces by Bernini and Caravaggio.
-  **Piazzale Scipione Borghese, Rome**
-  **Advance Booking:** Highly Recommended (Required)

12:30 PM – PIAZZA DEL POPOLO



- Visit the grand square and the "Twin Churches".
-  **Piazza del Popolo, Rome**

2:30 PM – CAMPO DE' FIORI MARKET



- Explore the lively open-air market for local produce.
-  **Campo de' Fiori, Rome**

4:30 PM – TRASTEVERE WANDER



- Walk through narrow cobblestone streets and vine-covered alleys.
-  **Trastevere District, Rome**

6:30 PM – JANICULUM HILL (GIANICOLO)



- A quiet spot for one of the best panoramic views of Rome.
